Maths - Capacity

In Grade 1 we have been exploring different components of measurement, in particular capacity. To conclude our measurement unit we had a capacity race. Before going outside to complete the race, we explored the different ways we could move the water from one bucket to the next. We also discussed how much each bucket and container could hold. Students thought of different strategies they could use such as running quickly with less water in the container, or walking slowly with a full container of water.

We then went outside in three different teams to test our skills! The capacity race was conducted three times. This allowed us the opportunity to discuss what we could change and/or do better to change our team's outcome each time.





Procedural Text Writing

In Grade one we have been exploring different text types. One form of text we explored was procedural writing. To conclude our learning of procedural texts, students completed an independent task for their portfolio. First, students read how to plant their own bean plant and then wrote a procedural text to explain the steps and materials needed if they were to show someone else how to plant a bean.
