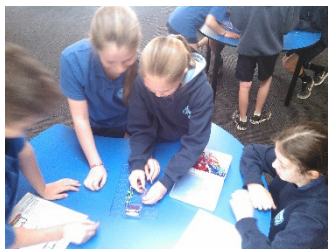

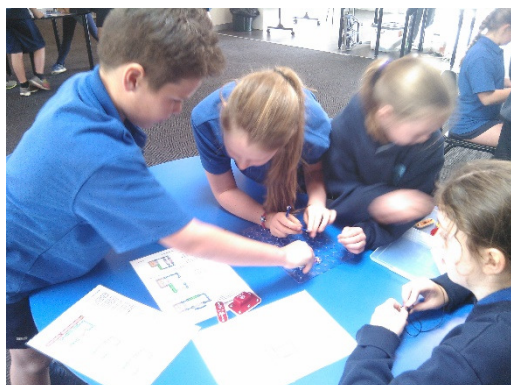
Electric BUZZ
