Panton Hill Primary School offers an Italian language program throughout the whole school. We begin with simple concepts such as colours, numbers and greetings. Units of work are often literature based. Students participate in a variety of activities which incorporate different learning styles such as songs, games, speaking and listening, reading and writing tasks, role-plays and ICT. The Upper School students are also exposed to cultural units such as famous Italians, geography units and cooking.

We celebrate Carnevale every year and students have the opportunity to dress up with an Italian theme bi-annually. During Carnevale, Italian language and culture is promoted with activities such as cooking, games and craft. This is a multi-age experience, where the whole school participates and the students work in mixed age groups and with a variety of teachers. Most of the day is dedicated to this celebration.
