NAPLAN

Our Grade 3's and 5's will be sitting the NAPLAN tests on the **15th, 16th and 17th March**. Our aim is to keep this as low key as possible to reduce any anxiety around these tests. Next week we will be giving the students an opportunity to familiarise themselves with the format through practice tests. The focus of this is to allow the students to have a sense of how to navigate through the tests as they are online. It also gives us an opportunity to ensure that we are not going to have any technical hiccups on the day.






