## **BUILDING WORKS UPDATE**

After site meetings this week, it has been confirmed that our building works will continue around the junior school building which also serves as our Shelter in Place (SIP). The purpose of all of these works is to ensure our SIP is as safe as possible in the event of a fire. Works will resume on painting the parts of the OSHC building that are 10metres from the SIP with a fire proof paint. Following this the existing wooden windows will be replaced with aluminium frames. Of course, safety of our school community is paramount when undertaking any works so there will be exclusion zones set up throughout this process. It is projected that these works will be completed by July.


